

General Statement - Social Media

We appreciate lots of parents visit and use the Facebook website as well as other social media, and this communication tool can be of huge benefit to parents. However, there are occasions when messages posted, particularly where children and staff are named, can be upsetting.

As you will appreciate, Burrowmoor Primary School does not condone this behaviour in any way. We would ask that you consider the implications of posting comments on social media and refrain from posting anything that could be hurtful or harmful to the children, staff or the school.

Should you receive a message of this nature we ask that you contact the school. When the school is informed, Ms Dobbs (or a member of the senior leadership team) will contact the writer and ask that the message is removed, and should the comments be of a serious nature further action will be taken.

Please remember: if you have a complaint your first point of call should be the school. It is not helpful (and in some cases counter-productive) to post on social media without giving the school the opportunity to respond appropriately.
